# Shape project - Background


- Adriatic/Mediterranean: one of the most vulnerable world seas,
- Subject of growing pressures,
- Growing attention to development/ environmental issues,
- New tools available: MSP, 1CZM
- SHAPE: Shaping a holistic approach to protect the Adriatic environment: between coast and sea
- development, testing, pilot application, promotion of tools among Adriatic partners







# Shape project — WP4



Act. 4.1 – Holistic management of the Adriatic Sea. Bridging the gap between EU Policy tools (WFD, ICZM, Natura 2000, Marine Strategy, MSP, IMP) and legal framework;

Act. 4.3 - MSP in the Adriatic: problem analysis and thematic mapping;


Act. 4.4 — Pilot project on MSP; integrating MSP and 1CZM
